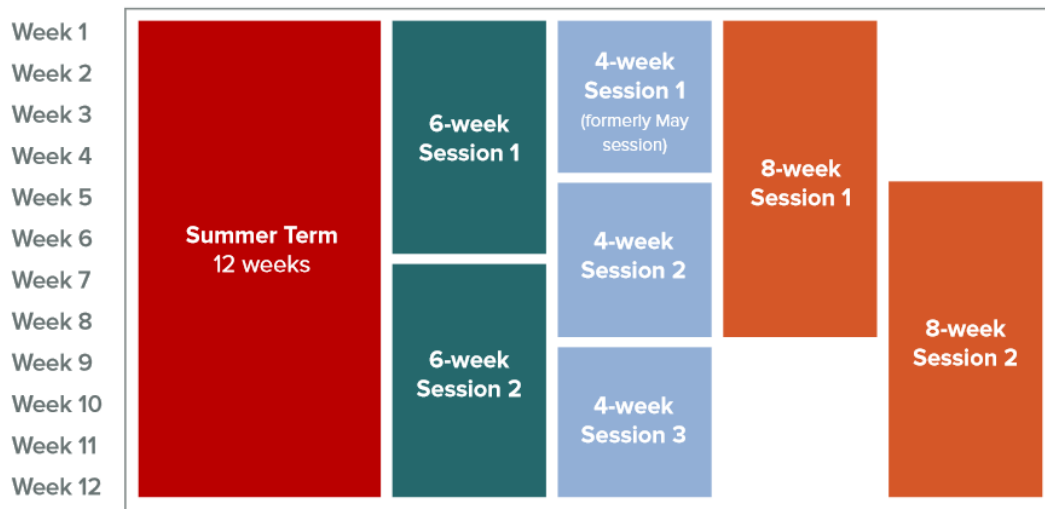

- Two 8-week sessions



### Summer 2022 Session Dates

4 week session 1: May 10 – June 3  
4 week session 2: June 6 – July 1  
4 week session 3: July 5 – July 29

6 week session 1: May 10 – June 17  
6 week session 2: June 21 – July 29

8 week session 1: May 10 – July 1  
8 week session 2: June 6 – July 29

12 week session (summer term): May 10 – July 29 (final exams August 1-3)

### **Cost of Summer Classes**

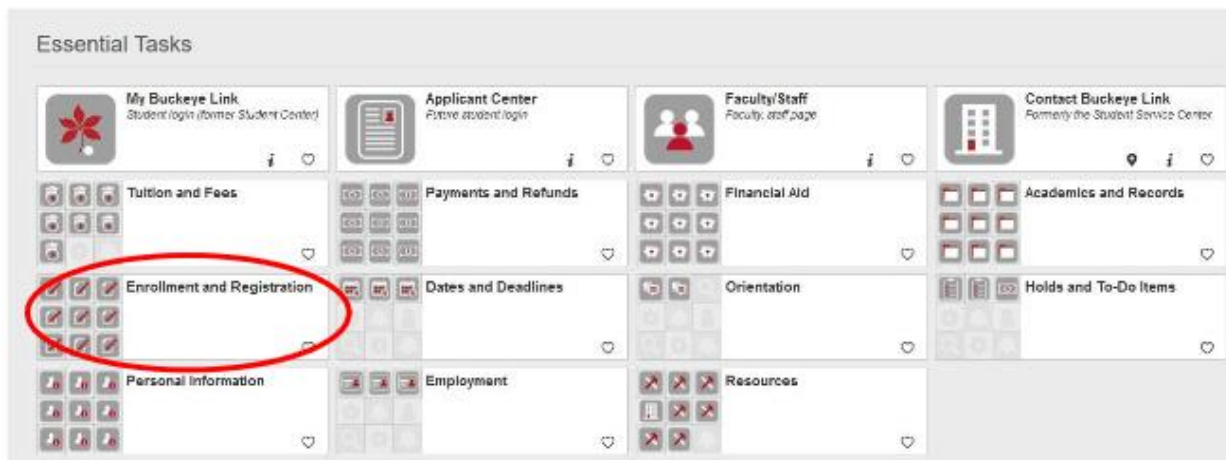

There is a 25% tuition discount for Columbus campus undergraduates for summer 2022. More information at <https://registrar.osu.edu/summerterm/>

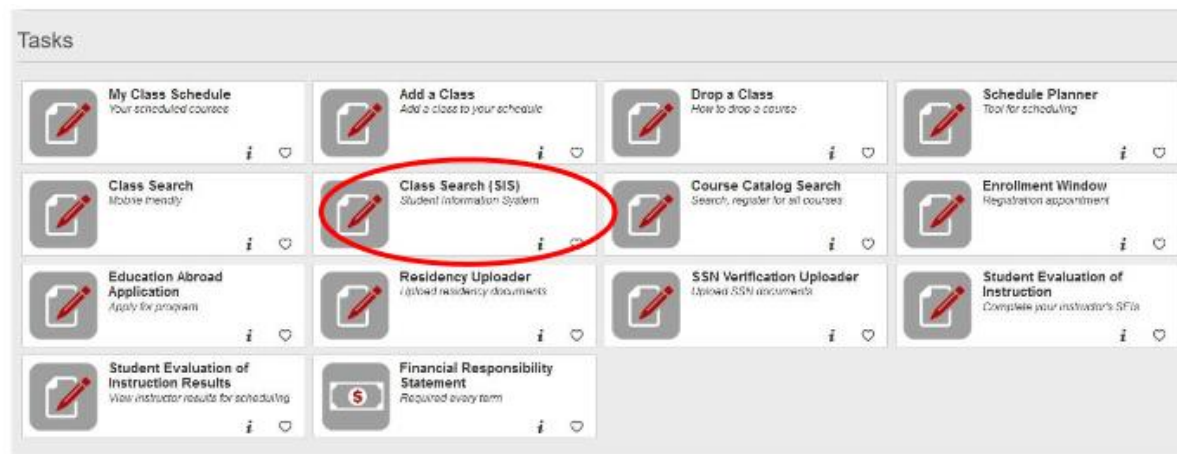
## How to Search for Courses by Session

To find the list of courses being offered during summer term, follow these steps.

**Step 1:** Go to [www.buckeyelink.osu.edu](http://www.buckeyelink.osu.edu) and click on “Enrollment and Registration”



**Step 2:** Click on “Class Search (SIS)”




**Step 3:** Choose “Summer 2022” as the term and “Columbus” as the campus unless you want to take a class on a regional campus. Then click “Additional Search Criteria”. The “session” drop-down menu will allow you to narrow down your search if you’re looking to take a course during a specific session within summer term.



## How to Search for Online Courses

Follow the instructions on pages 4 and 5 but instead of selecting a Session, choose “Distance Learning” from the Mode of Instruction drop-down menu.

## When Can I Register for Summer Courses?

Each student will have their own unique scheduling appointment - a specific day and time after which they can register for classes. To check yours, log in to your BuckeyeLink account and click on the “details” link in the blue Enrollment Information box on the right-hand side of your screen.



Then choose the “Summer 2022 Term” bubble and click “continue”. Your enrollment appointment will be shown in the “Appointment Begins” column. You should be able to register for summer classes after the day and time listed.

Don’t forget that scheduling windows are assigned based on rank. Student athletes, those with disabilities, and honors students schedule first. From there seniors schedule, then juniors, sophomores, and freshmen.

## Summer Physics Courses at OSU

The OSU Department of Physics is offering the following courses during the Summer of 2022 that may be of interest to Physics and Engineering Physics majors.

**Physics 1250** - lecture TuWeFr 10:35-11:45am, recitation at Mo 10:35-11:45am, and lab at Th 9:40-11:45am. 12-week full summer term course. The lecture is currently listed as online with in-person recitation and lab, but we expect the course to be 100% in-person.

**Physics 1251** – lecture TuWeFr 3:20-4:30pm, recitation at Mo 3:20-4:30pm, and lab at either Th 12:05-2:10pm or Th 2:25-4:30pm. 12-week full summer term course. The course will take place 100% in-person.

**Physics 3700** – lecture MoTuWeThFr 12:05-1:00pm, lab at MoTuWeThFr 1:15-5:15pm. 4-week session 1 course. The course will take place 100% in-person. In order to register, please contact your Physics advisor, David Zach (zach.11@osu.edu) or Lindsey Thaler (thaler.21@osu.edu), so that they can enroll you into the course. There is a possibility of a second section opening up (same lecture time, lab time in the morning) if there is enough demand, although it is not expected at this time. Please note that this is an accelerated course (a normal 15-week course being taught in only 4 weeks), so expect for it to be time consuming.

## Taking Classes at a Different School

If you're considering taking a class at a different university or college during the summer of 2022, please contact your Physics advisor, David Zach (zach.11@osu.edu) or Lindsey Thaler (thaler.21@osu.edu), to discuss the process of transferring courses. You should make sure OSU will accept the transfer credit BEFORE you take the class.
