We plan to appoint two postdoctoral fellows in the Condensed Matter Theory group at the Ohio State University. Both positions will be in the general area of quantum condensed matter physics, including correlated quantum materials, topological phases of matter, quantum dynamics and cold atoms. We would greatly appreciate your bringing this opportunity to the attention of strong candidates. Successful candidates will carry out research in the condensed matter theory group with Professors Yuan-Ming Lu, Mohit Randeria, and Nandini Trivedi. They will also have opportunities to interact with Professors Ilya Gruzberg and Jason Ho, and with members of the condensed matter experimental group and the Center for Emergent Materials (CEM), an NSF-MRSEC (<http://cem.osu.edu/>).
