- 4. You will be required to create your own National Instruments online account. Doing so will also give you access to NI support. Enter your registration information and select the appropriate role from the "What best describes your role?" drop-down menu option.
- Proceed to download your trial copy of LabView. Ignore additional software downloads. If you have issues downloading or installing LabView, please contact National Instruments support using the account you created.
